

## I. Terms and Conditions for Materials Submitted to Pixingo

All materials submitted to Pixingo (including but not limited to text, graphics, photographs, images, and any and all other materials (collectively, "User Submissions")) are subject to the following terms and conditions.

- 1) You own all User Submissions. By uploading, transferring, or otherwise submitting User Submissions to Pixingo, you grant to Pixingo and its designees a worldwide, non-exclusive, transferable, royalty-free, perpetual, and irrevocable right and license, with right of sublicense, to use, reproduce, distribute, create derivative works of, and publicly display any and all such User Submissions in connection with the provision, production or promotion of any product or service by Pixingo.
- 2) You represent and warrant that you own or otherwise possess all necessary rights with respect to the User Submissions; that your User Submissions do not and will not infringe, misappropriate, use or disclose without authorization, or otherwise violate any copyright, trade secret right or other intellectual property or property right of any third party; that the User Submissions are not unlawful, fraudulent, threatening, abusive, libelous, defamatory, obscene or otherwise objectionable; and that you have the right to grant the licenses heretofore granted to Pixingo.
- 3) None of the User Submissions will be subject to any obligation whatsoever, whether of confidentiality, attribution or otherwise, on Pixingo's part or on the part of any of Pixingo's assignees, sublicensees or designees, and neither Pixingo nor its assignees, sublicensees or designees will be liable for any use or disclosure of any such User Submissions.
- 4) You agree that Pixingo may (but is under no obligation to) filter and/or screen any User Submissions, alter or refuse to use any User Submissions, and/or disclose any User Submissions and the circumstances surrounding the use thereof, to any third party in order to provide the applicable products or services, to protect Pixingo or Pixingo's affiliates, distributors, partners, licensors, licensees or other third parties, to comply with legal obligations or governmental requests, or for any other reason or purpose.
- 5) You agree to indemnify, defend and hold Pixingo and its directors, officers, shareholders, employees, consultants, agents, representatives, affiliates, distributors, partners, licensees, producers, manufacturers, and third party users harmless from and

against any and all claims, liabilities, causes of action, damages, losses and expenses (including, without limitation, attorneys' fees) that arise directly or indirectly out of or from: (i) your breach of these terms, any other agreement or terms of use with Pixingo, and any representation or warranty contained herein or therein; (ii) your User Submissions; and/or (iii) your activities in connection with obtaining any products or services from Pixingo.

## **II. Pixingo Copyright Policy**

Pixingo respects the intellectual property rights of others and expects users of Pixingo services to do the same. In accordance with the Digital Millennium Copyright Act of 1998 (the "DMCA") (the text of which may be found on the U.S. Copyright Office website at http://lcweb.loc.gov/copyright/), it is Pixingo's policy to respond to notices of any actual or alleged infringement and to terminate the accounts of repeat infringers in appropriate circumstances. If you believe in good faith that a work has been copied in a way that constitutes an infringement of your copyright, you should send a notice requesting that the material be removed, or access to it blocked. The notice must include the following: (i) a physical or electronic signature of a person authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is alleged to be infringed; (ii) identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed; (iii) identification of the material that is claimed to be infringing or the subject of infringing activity, and information reasonably sufficient to allow Pixingo to locate the material on the Pixingo website; (iv) a statement that the complaining party has a good faith belief that use of the material in the manner complained of is not authorized by the copyright owner, its agent or the law; and (v) a statement that the information in the notification is accurate and, under penalty of perjury, that the complaining party is authorized to act on behalf of the owner of an exclusive right that is allegedly infringed. If you believe in good faith that a notice of copyright infringement has been wrongly filed against you, the DMCA permits you to send Pixingo a counter-notice.
